Arequipa has become the city where the contagion of the virus is very, very high and 30 to 40 people die every day and this week they have found the Indian strain that is much more lethal.

Hospitals are completely full and doctors are tired of work and many have been infected.

Our dear boss Tania, director of MMI and some colleagues have also been infected and thank God they are overcoming. For this time, I will not go because the contagion is very strong and from July 15 I will go and after that they apply the second dose to me.



On the other hand, in Peru we are at the time of presidential elections and the candidates are a professor Castillo from rural areas and Mrs. Fujimori, both with extreme positions of the right and socialism and each with their own problems. Sunday June 6 was the elections and the teacher is won with some scores. But the critical issue is that people gather in large crowds in the squares of Lima, without the slightest protection care, without a doubt that there will be infected with covid 19, this situation is very sad at this time in Peru.



Today, Saturday, my grandson Josué turns 2 years old, his parents have already received the vaccines and thank God they are well supporting the Emanuel church in Quilpué, about 20 minutes from Valparaíso.
